Adjudication Selection Process

- Only judges, timekeepers and students are allowed in the auditorium. Parents, family members, and teachers are invited to wait in the lounge.
- No student will be judged by immediate family or current teachers/instructors.
- Students may submit up to (3) works of art in any medium.
- Students will be identified by number **ONLY**.
- Judges will have no discussion with the student artists except when asking the student a question (see #5 in criteria below).
- Students will be judged on a scale of 1–10 with a total possible score of 50 points.

Students will be judged on the following criteria

1. **DESIGN**- Cohesiveness of composition.
2. **EXPRESSION/FLEXIBILITY** - Communicative quality and variety of work.
3. **ORIGINALITY**- Novel and unique solutions.
4. **USE OF MEDIA** - Proficiency in technique and of ideas.
5. **INTERVIEW QUESTIONS** - Students will be asked (2) questions about their artwork.
