GENERAL GUIDELINES

◆ **Who Can Apply?**

- ◆ The program is open to Chesapeake residents of six (6) months before application is submitted. Students must be ages 12-18.
- ◆ Students **must skip the year after they receive an ARTS ALIVE award.** They may apply the following year.
- ◆ Students may apply in more than one discipline, but must submit a separate application for each. However, students do not have to submit additional application fees.
- ◆ The program does not discriminate on the basis of race or sex.

◆ **When and where to apply?**

◆ **Award .**

- ◆ Award/prize funds will be presented in April 2012.
- ◆ Written notification will be mailed to all applicants within approximately one month after the Qualifying Performances.
- ◆ A written evaluation by the Award recipient should be sent to the Friends and the Commission. For any publicity relating to your attendance or performance, sponsoring credit should be given to the Friends and the Commission and evidence (news articles, programs, brochures, etc.) should be forwarded with the written report.
